

#### **BULGARIA**

- The Republic of Bulgaria is a country in Southeast Europe. It is located in the eastern part of the Balkan Peninsula and occupies 23% of its territory. Bordering north with Romania; to the west with Serbia and the Republic of Macedonia; to the south with Greece and to the southeast with Turkey. To the east, along the coast, the country is washed by the waters of the Black Sea. With its nearly 111,000 km² area and 7,153 million people, Bulgaria ranks 11th and 16th respectively in terms of area and population in the European Union.
- The earliest testimonies of human presence on the lands of present-day Bulgaria date back to 200-100 thousand years ago, or the age of the Paleolithic. In 681, the First Bulgarian State was founded, which reached its peak in development at the beginning of the 10th century and exerted a great influence on Eastern European peoples through its literary schools and literature.



#### **POPOVO**

- There are three prehistoric mounds of the Eneolithic and Chalcolithic settlements in the Popovo area, one northwest of the city and one Nevsky and Seyachi neighborhoods, as well as nine Thracian tombstones from the Roman epoch. Tombstone mounds are divided into two mound necropolises, but most of them are already destroyed by treasure excavations. On the village mounds in the past are also found traces of ancient and medieval constructions. To the southeast of the former pigs complex of the city is the largest ancient settlement of the Roman era in the Popovo area. West of Popovo under the villa zone in the past were also found remains of a small medieval settlement from the First Bulgarian Kingdom.
- Popovo was also the center of the largest market for live animals in Northeastern Bulgaria. After 1947, almost all major and important industrial capacities were transferred to the town of Targovishte to give the industry a start.
